## OBJECTIVES

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**The main aim** of the youth exchange “Dream big” is to introduce the participants to the world of entrepreneurship as a solution for the unemployment.

We would like to achieve this goal through sports. Our strong believe is that if youngsters accept the right attitude to be successful in sports, the same attitude will serve them to be successful in the business world. Actually, the similarities between entrepreneurs and athletes are striking.

**The objectives** of the youth exchange are:

- Raising awareness about entrepreneurship education
- Exchange of best practices between the participants
- Foster future cooperation among organisations
- Raising awareness about Erasmus+ program
- Fighting youth unemployment as a common problem in Europe using non-formal learning tools

## CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPANT'S SELECTION

- Presents knowledge / interest for entrepreneurship
- Commitment to participate in the whole duration of the activity
- Clear ideas for follow up activities at local/ national and international levels
- Involvement in creating initiatives and their work with young people with fewer opportunities
- Share expectations and clearly defined learning needs
- Commitment to reflect on personal learning process and ability to critically assess learning outcomes
- Openness for and appreciation of non-formal learning process in highly diverse context

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- No age limit
- Have interpersonal and communication skills, strategic thinking oriented to results
- Promote a positive attitude at the group level
- Have coordination, planning and organisation skills
- Have an advanced level of English
- Have experience in volunteering, non-formal education and youth
- Promote active engagement and teamwork

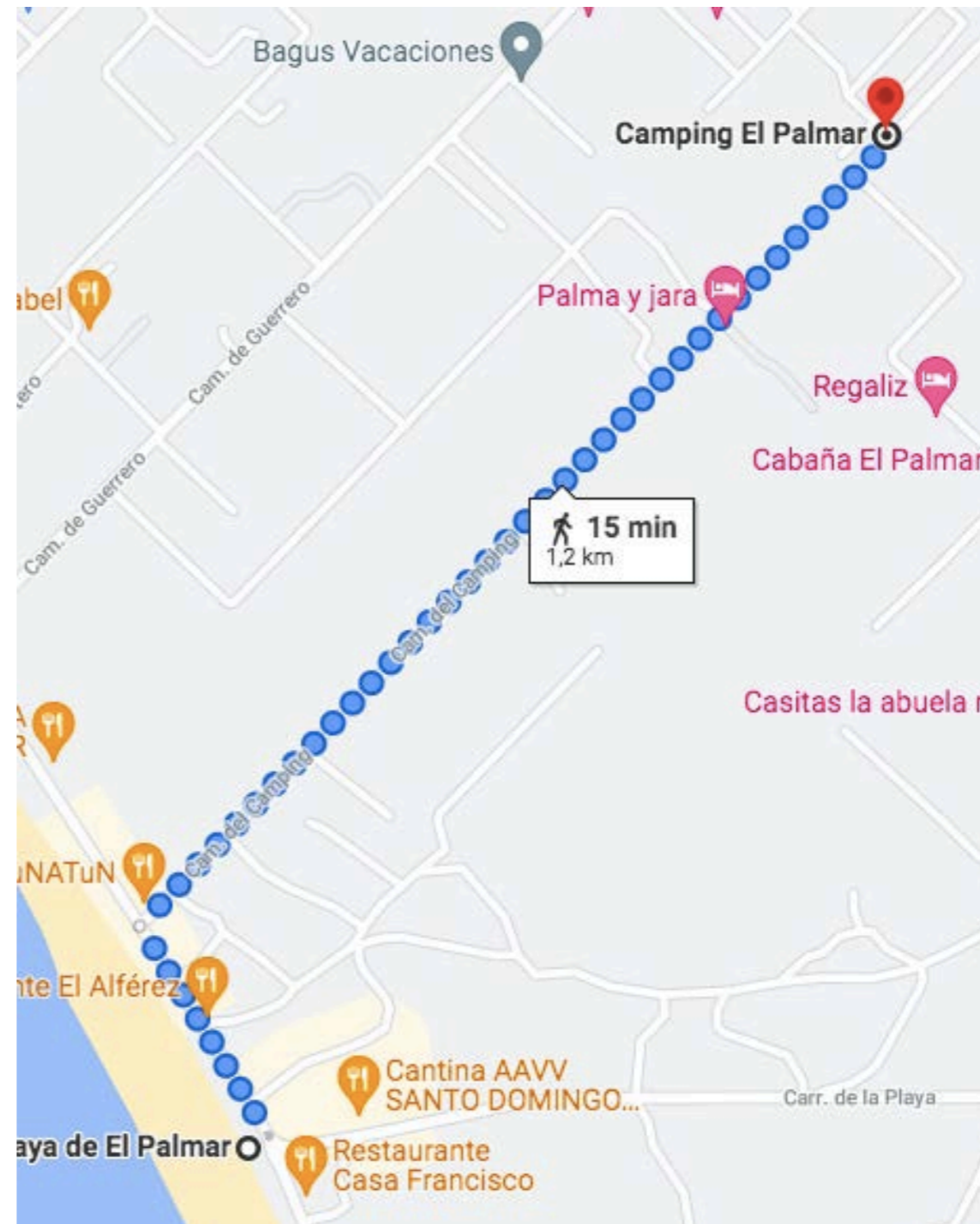

## FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Dates of the project (youth exchange): 03-10.05.2020.

You need to be at the eco-rural house before 19:00 on the 3rd and departure time from the venue will be on the 10th around 12:00.

Transportation costs of all participants will be covered by project's budget up to Erasmus+ limits of transportation costs for a certain country, based on Erasmus+ distance calculator.

Participants are required to provide the hosting organization all travel documents maximum until the second day of the main activities (5th of May).

Buying all tickets is an obligation of participants (with partners' organization support).

**!!! PLEASE DO NOT buy your tickets without having confirmation from the organizers**

As soon as you filled the registration form and your participation is confirmed, you are kindly requested to submit your travel proposal for validation including detailed information about name(s) of the participant(s), itinerary (departure, arrival, dates, hours, transport company), type of transport (flight, bus, train) here: [kmon.asoc@gmail.com](mailto:kmon.asoc@gmail.com)

All costs related to accommodation, and food (3 meals per day - breakfast, lunch, supper and 2 coffee breaks) will be covered by project's budget.

## DON'T FORGET:

To send via e-mail and bring invoices of your tickets, since we can not reimburse anything without documentation. Boarding passes are obligatory as well.





## REGULAR TICKETS:

- The original invoice/receipt/pay order/proof of payment
- The original boarding passes
- The prices stated in the invoices must coincide with the price on the ticket



## E-TICKETS MUST BE:

- Printed out and include your name, the exact fare you paid, details of your flight on the same page
- Provided along with the credit card receipt for the payment or a copy of bank statement
- Given with the boarding passes



## OTHER IMPORTANT DETAILS:

- Booking paper alone is not enough (we need the invoices)
- Missing or lost tickets are not reimbursed
- Any costs for taxi or petrol are not reimbursed
- Return tickets must be bought in advance before the journey
- Following the guidelines of the Erasmus+/YIA Programme  
Please know that the total duration of the extra stay should not extend 2 day - meaning - one day before and one day after, or 2 days before or 2 days after.

**Tickets with longer extra stay will NOT be reimbursed.**

## NOTE:

The reimbursement will be done by bank transfer, for all participants in the NGO or team leader accounts when all documents are fulfilled:

- All travel documents are in KMON NGO possession
- The participants have completed the dissemination activities
- Leaders have completed the Mobility Tool Online survey after activity.

## WHAT TO BRING

- Comfortable clothes (tracksuit, comfy t-shirts for both indoor and outdoor activities) and shoes for workshops depending on weather, slippers
- Traditional food, drinks, souvenirs for intercultural evenings activities.
- A traditional mug
- Good mood

## INSURANCE & HEALTH ISSUES

Participants are themselves responsible to get a travel insurance. We do encourage to purchase at least European insurance Card or an Additional Travel Insurance. If anyone who uses medicine should bring with themselves. We don't give any medicines and we don't cover insurance fees.

# NATIONAL GROUPS' TASKS

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## ☑ BEFORE THE ACTIVITY

- Getting familiar with the situation in the local community of sending organization
- Collect and prepare at least 2 traditional games that can be re-framed through non-formal education
- Prepare at least 2 energisers
- Fulfill the participation form on-line
- Purchase and collect all travel tickets after consultation and agreement with the hosting organization

## ☑ AFTER THE MAIN ACTIVITY

- To disseminate results, both off and on-line
- To fill in a EC's survey that will be delivered via participant's / leaders' e-mail

## ☑ DURING THE YOUTH EXCHANGE

- To deliver all travel documents to the hosting organization (Asociación K'MON)
- To actively participate in all workshop sessions (100% of the activities)

- To actively collaborate during "intercultural evenings" phase
- To present a good practices and an actual situation according to youth work and participants' environment/region/country

## ☑ DURING THE LOCAL PHASE

- To disseminate results of the project via all possible channels (youtube, twitter, Facebook, local newspaper) and send all links to the hosting organization
- To keep informing hosting and partner organisations about results, doubts and challenges during implementation phase
