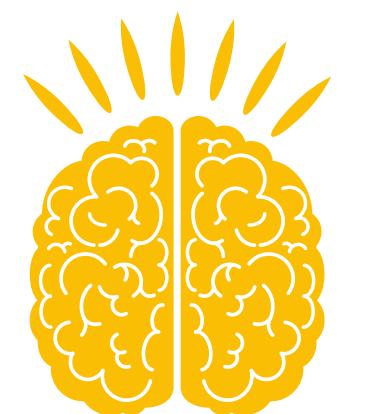

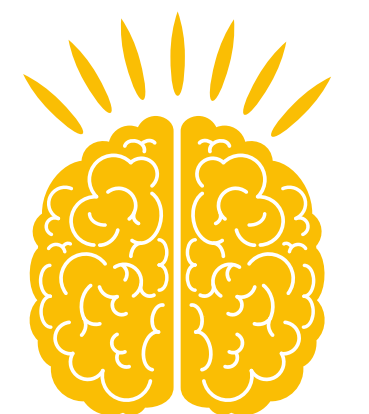


TDM2000 Polska is the Polish branch of TDM2000 International network.

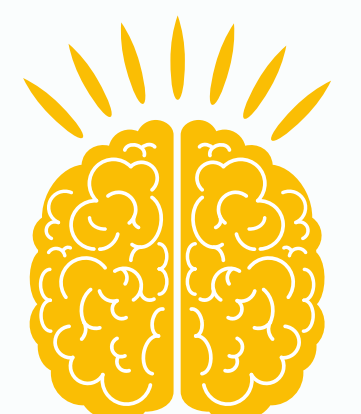

budget for travel

According to the general rules of the Erasmus+ programme and the distance calculator, the maximum travel cost are:

- **180 EUR** - Czech Republic
- **275 EUR** - Croatia, Greece, Italy, North Macedonia, Lithuania, Romania
- **360 EUR** - Portugal

It's not a problem if you want to arrive or stay 1-2 days before or after the project. **All travel details before purchase must be agreed with hosting organisation.**

To receive reimbursement we ask you to collect documents:

- boarding passes
- invoices/bills and tickets
- confirmation e-mails

Before you purchase your flight tickets you must receive our confirmation!

- Polish national currency is Zloty (Polish Złoty, PLN). 1 EUR is approximately 4,65PLN;
- Exchange rate at the airport is usually lower than in the city so try not to change big amount of money there. Polish word for an exchange office is KANTOR.
- Weather in December is usually quite cold, temperatures may vary from -15 to +5 degrees with possible snow.
- Nights may be quite cold, so please make sure to bring some warmer clothes with you.
- Most useful Polish expressions:
 - 1) Przepraszam – I am sorry / Excuse me
 - 2) Dziękuję – Thank you
 - 3) Proszę – Please / You are welcome
 - 4) Pomocy! - Help!
