

About the project


The Perform is a **training course** for youth workers, educators, youth leaders who would like to develop their competencies in using the **comedy theatre methodology** for social inclusion and promotion of environmental protection and would like to discover and gain better insight in the methodology of performative art. In the end of the training participants will prepare and develop their performance which they will present in local school and which will be transmited online.





The main purpose is to promote social inclusion, environmental protection and methodology of performative art. We would like to equip youth workers with theatre methodology to promote social inclusion and environemntal protection as well as developing the methodology of performative art where young people can learn through process of theatre performances.



Methodology

During the training participants will take part in the workshops based on non-formal educational methodology as theatre methodology, comedy theatre, mime, physical theatre, working in pairs, groups, brainstorming, reflecting, performing, acting, team building, self-reflection, group reflections, role-play. The main methodology of the training would be **comedy theatre**.

Comedy theatre focuses on developing the characters and the stories which can easily break the social paterns because they are comedy players, bringing the taboo-topics to the audience to reflect on it. Creating the comedy stories which are tackling the difficult topics make it more accesible to reflection and conversation by the public.

The leading learning approach during the training course would be experiential learning (D. Kolb). Participants will go through the learning process which is following the cycle of experience, analyse, conceptualization and practise.

#2

The second approach is learning through creating the performance, which gives the actors deeper reflection on their performance and growth of their personal and professional competencies.

Learning approach



The activities would be dedicated to increase competences in field of social inclusion, environmental protection, theatre methodology and comedy theatre. Most of the activities would be based on theatre methodology which may require acting, playing, role-playing, improvising.

In the end of the training participants will prepare and perform theatre performance which would be transmited online.


Daily there would be at least 6 hours of workshops and time for reflection. (Every day we will start workshops at 9:30 and finish around 19 o'clock, with 2 coffee breaks and lunch break).



Place and () Venue


The training course will take place in Murzasichle-the small town in the Tatra mountains, near Zakopane (the winter capitol of Poland). Participants will stay in bedrooms (2-4 people in rooms with the same gender) with bathrooms. All activities will take place in the workshop room in the next building. In the venue there would be a canteen which will provide the meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and coffee breaks with the traditional highlander cousine.





Living conditions

All together we will take care of our space where we will live, work and learn, therefore we need to keep the place clean and useful for our activities. During the theatrical activities we will walk in the workshop room barefoot or in socks (so take some warm socks if you get cold easily).




Dissemination activities

The dissemination of the project's results is one of our priorities as it is increasing the impact of our action. After the project participants are obligated to make follow-up activities till the **24th of May**. What requires preparation for those activities before the training.

- Organize 2 workshops in your local community (one involving at least 10 youth workers) and educators, second involving at least 20 youth)
- Write the article about the training in English and national language (one per country)
- Promote the project on social media (Facebook and Instagram)
- Promote the results of the project
- Write personal diary about your learning journey
- Write outline for future project aiming social inclusion or environmental protection (one per country)
- Create the poster about the project (one per country)





Due to environmental protection we would recommend to lower the carbon emission during the travel (promote train/bus transportation, direct flights).

Selected participants could start finding a connection to Kraków. Please, send to us proposal of your travel (which includes travel company, time, date of arrival and departure, price), later we will give you our confirmation to buy them. Tickets bought without our confirmation will not be reimbursed. More about the reimbursement process, in the next section.

Tickets should be bought by low fare prices, only second class. You can arrive to Poland in total 2 days before or after the main activities, however we can not cover expenses of your venue and meals before or after the activities.

On the 16th of April we are going to meet around 18 o'clock near the main train station in Kraków. Then we will go with the shuttle bus to our venue (the cost of the shuttle bus will be reduced from the travel reimbursement limits).

Plan your travel to be on the 16th of April before 18 o'clock in Kraków around train station. On the 24th of April we will leave our venue around 8 in the morning. Please, plan your departure from Kraków after 12 o'clock (the flights from Kraków should be after 1:30pm). After our approval of your ticket proposal, you can buy them and upload to our google drive.

The closest airports to Kraków are in Kraków, Katowice, Warszawa. From those cities you can take the train to Kraków (check out the schedule <u>HERE</u>)

Reimbursement

Reimbursement of the tickets would be done after finalizing all following tasks by participants (up to the national limits):

- filling in the reimbursement form before 10th of April 2023
- sending all boarding passes and tickets to hosting team till 6th of April 2023
- implementing all of the follow-up activities till 24th of May 2023
- filling in the questionary after the activities till 30th of April 2023

When all participants finish all tasks, we will start to reimburse your travel costs by sending transfers to each participant. The transfers will be sent within 3 weeks from the deadline for uploading all materials from follow-up activities (only if the participants accomplish all follow-up activities). In case of not fullfilling all follow-up tasks or not sending all documents to hosting organisation, the participant's travel reimbursement would be considered as voluntary contribution to the project.
