









Working methods



All activities will be done through the methods of **non-formal education** that is a voluntary, non hierarchical approach and all its methods are based on the concept of learning by doing.



Most relevant method used will be **Newspaper Theatre** along with ice breakers, team building activities, brainstorming, working in small groups, plenary discussions, group evaluation, infographics etc.

Project Objectives



- O1. Mapping the causes and stakeholders behind the lack of security in the online environment
- O2. Involvement of youth workers through creative methods in the prevention of hate speech, cyberbullying and fake news
- O3. To discover alternatives and counter-discourses aimed at greater inclusion of vulnerable groups
- O4. Improving the critical thinking of the participants in approaching online information in order to develop their ability to detect and react to false information
- O5. Guiding youth workers in planning and managing online campaigns using social media





PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

The participants involved in this project will be youth workers interested in civic involvement, education and according to the following profile:

- A minimum age of 18
- Strong motivation to learn and acquire new skills;
- Attitude for dialogue and mutual understanding;
- Gender Balance have to be followed as much as possible;
- Priority will be given to youth workers with fewer opportunities background and at their first Erasmus+ experience



TRAVEL REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE

- BE AWARE that the reimbursement will be calculated according to the travel costs of participants from their place of origin to the venue of the activity and return.


ABOUT TICKETS

HOW TO REACH BUCHAREST



To travel to ROMANIA and reach the venue you need to travel to **HENRI COANDA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.**

From airport you need to take the train to **GARA DE NORD** BUCHAREST (**BUCURESTI NORD**) - (around 30 minutes travel each half an hour)




From GARA DE NORD (BUCURESTI NORD) you need to take the **SUBWAY M1** (yellow route to REPUBLICA or PANTELIMON direction) directly to **Grozăvești station** (4 stations).

From subway you have to **walk** 450 m to Hotel Ambiance (https://maps.app.goo.gl/Wcj4NKhxUSVzNxzKA) - Splaiul Independenței nr. 303






What to bring

- · Local Currency (optional);




Local currency



Currency in Romania is LEI (RON)

1 euro is around 5 lei, train ticket from airport to main train station (Gara de Nord) is around 1 euro and subway ticket is also around 1 euro for 2 travels /ways.
