PROJECT SUMMARY

This project focuses on **Non-Formal Education** (NFE) as powerful process that can effectively address the evolving needs of the learners, offering a variety of approaches that ensure **inclusivity** and **empowerment**.


Through NFE principles and practices, the project aims to offer space for **experimentation** and **competence development**, fostering motivation for **lifelong learning**

In this context, our project aims to become a fruitful space to share, test and further develop NFE tools, methods and techniques in youth work practice, specifically focusing on theatre methods and performative acts. This is done, first of all, through a Study Visit (11-15 March 2024, in Sweden), designed to witness the hands-on work of experienced organizations delivering theatre-based activities, and it continues with a Training Course (2-8 May 2024), aimed at developing youth workers' professional competences, to which this infopack is specifically referred



MAIN OBJECTIVES

Through NFE methodologies, our project aims to provide participants with the right tools to support their learning process towards active citizenship, creating an experiential and inclusive environment. Below the project structure and objectives:

HOW TO GET THERE?





N.B. It is very important, before buying any tickets, to forward us your travel itinerary! If you land too late, or depart too early, we won't be able to assist you in reaching the venue or catching your flight

Landing in Naples



1) Take the bus to the **main railway station** of Napoli, **Garibaldi**. The bus is named **Alibus**, from ANM company and you can follow the directions on the boards at the exit of the arrival terminal to reach the stop. Here's the timetable:

2) Take the regional train to **Vairano-Caianello**. Trains are quite frequent (every 1–2 hours), but last one is usually scheduled around 19:50. Check on **Trenitalia website** to customize your search and buy tickets: https://www.trenitalia.com/en.html

Landing in Rome - Ciampino or Fiumicino



1) Take a bus to the **main railway station** of Rome, **Termini**. There are **several companies** for this route: Terravision, Schiaffini, Cotral, etc. Follow the directions on the boards at the exit of the arrival terminal to reach the stops. You can buy your ticket in advance on bus companies' websites (recommended), or directly at the stops.

2) Take the train to **Vairano-Caianello**. There are few direct trains (take options with <u>no change</u>), and last one is usually scheduled around 18:00. Check on **Trenitalia website** to customize your search and buy tickets: https://www.trenitalia.com/en.html

Once in Vairano-Caianello, we will arrange transportation. Pick-up will be guaranteed only from 5 pm on the 2nd of May; therefore, plan your trip accordingly. On the 8th of May, check-out is due by 10 am, and we will arrange transfers based on your travel plans



FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT



The budget limit for each participant is the following:



Greece, Lithuania, North Macedonia, Poland, Portugal, Romania: 275€

Sweden: 360€

If you exceed the budget, it will be up to you to **cover** the **extra expenses**. In case the amount of your ticket is not written in euro, we will use the European commission **currency converter** with the exchange rate of the day of your purchase.

The above budget includes all the means of transportation for the **round trip**, but TAXI, car sharing services and other similar private transportations are **not refundable** (e.g. Uber, MyTaxi, Blablacar, etc.). Return tickets must all be provided by postal service once you come back home, unless you have the chance to provide them to us during the training itself (highly recommended).

You will need to be in Italy on the **2nd of May** and to leave on the **8th**. Nevertheless, you are allowed to stay for a total of **2 extra days** (before, after, or a combination of both), but keep in mind that the project budget **doesn't cover** food and accommodation outside of the official dates (from dinner of the 2nd to breakfast of the 8th).

This will be reimbursed only if these **4 conditions** are fulfilled by **EACH MEMBER OF YOUR GROUP**:

- 1) You gave all the **ORIGINAL tickets** and **boarding passes** to our organization. It is fundamental to bring the invoices or the travel confirmations where is clearly shown:
- the name & surname of the traveler;
- the cost incurred/price paid;
- the date and itinerary of the travel;
- the date of the purchase;



- 2) You attended the **full duration** of the Training. Absence to any activity is only allowed for justified and proven reasons, communicated beforehand to the trainers;
- 3) You submitted every survey and report that our organization or EU requested;
- 4) You did your planned **dissemination** and follow-up activity, with **evidence** of implementation;





VENUE, FOOD AND ACCOMMODATION





Masseria Cardilli in Presenzano is a charming agritourism destination set in Italy's beautiful countryside. This farmstay offers an authentic experience of rural Italian life and hospitatlity. The venue has wide **external spaces** that can be used for our activities, or just to enjoy and relax during the informal and free time

You will share same-sex rooms for three people, with participants from other Countries. Rooms are equipped with private bathrooms, bed linen and towels. You will be provided with three meals per day, plus two coffee breaks in between the morning and the afternoon sessions. Since you will be hosted in Italy, meals will mainly be "Italian style", to let you properly discover and delve into Italian food tradition! Get ready to taste delicious pasta and sweet breakfast with homemade cakes and pies!



HEALTH INSURANCE



Before coming to Italy, please make sure that you have a valid insurance! If you are EU resident, bring (or request if you don't have it yet) your **European Health Insurance Card** (EHIC), while if you are not eligible for it, you can buy a **travel insurance** when booking your flights, since every company give it as option. Such insurance must **cover medical treatments** and expenses abroad. This is absolutely **a must** to join the project.

Costs regarding Health Insurance can be reimbursed **ONLY** to the participants not eligible for EHIC and **ONLY** if insurance is bought together with the flight ticket in the same invoice/confirmation. Any other scenario will **NOT** be taken into consideration.



Keep in mind that it will always be your full responsibility to comply with all the **safety rules** and **regulations** while participating to the training
