Travel reimbursement conditions



Buying tickets and getting to the YE venue is an obligation of the participants.

To be reimbursed, the participant has to provide us with travel documents:

bus/train tickets, boarding passes, bills and invoices and, if requested, evidence of payment (e.g. credit/debit card statement), proof of payment for the visa (if applicable).

.Taxi costs can not be reimbursed, bu provide information for special case

Before purchasing the tickets, please consult the route and cost with your sending and hosting organisation.

We cannot reimburse the cost of travel insurance.

Travel reimbursements will be made directly to the participants on the last day of the activities.

Leaders of the groups will be responsible for collecting the afore-mentioned travel documents and sending them to us.

Venue

The venue of the project will be shared with the participants once the selection process is complete.

Tips

- Consider buying travel insurance (we cannot reimburse its cost).
 - Please take photos of travel documents or save them (invoices, bills and boarding passes) on your device. Don't throw away paper documents.
 - If possible, each country group should bring some traditional snacks, beverages and clothes from their countries to share with other participants during the intercultural evenings. Please also bring with you your national flag.
 - Once your organisation confirms your participation, you'll be invited to join our private groups on Facebook and WhatsApp. Each country group should have at least one laptop per group with a basic video editor (e.g. Clipchamp) and presentation programme (e.g. PowerPoint, canva). Participants will use their phones to shoot videos.
 - During the project the use of alcohol is strictly forbidden.
 - Rooms will be divided according to the same gender but different nationalities.
 - At the end of the project, each participant will receive a Youthpass certificate.
 - We especially ask the participants to bring positive thoughts with them.
